3. Assist with staff training.
4. Responds to emergencies.

REQUIREMENTS/EDUCATION:

1. Must be at least 16 years of age.
2. Current NLS Award, Standard First Aid and CPR-C certifications, AED, and Vulnerable Sector Screening.
3. Excellent customer service skills with the ability to understand and respond in a timely manner using problem solving and/or conflict resolution skills, tact and diplomacy.
4. Excellent leadership, oral and written communication skills.
5. Must be prepared to work flexible hours involving evenings and weekends.
6. To attend all scheduled orientation and training sessions and to obtain additional related certifications as required (i.e. aquatic specialty certifications).

Aquatic staff hiring consists of both a wet and a dry interview. A 'dry' interview will only be arranged upon successful completion of a 'wet' interview.
