The Father E. Bulfon Outdoor Rink revitalization project, successfully executed by the Facility Services Department, was featured in the Ontario Recreation Facilities Association's Facility Forum Magazine.

The City of Vaughan is recognized as "The Big Winner" for the revitalization which uses significantly less utilities and dramatically less resources, boasts an enhanced user experience and will last for the next 25 years. The renewed facility includes a new refrigeration plant, outdoor rink and players benches.

David C. Onley Award for Leadership in Accessibility | December 2018

The City of Vaughan was one of four organizations from across Ontario that was recognized with the David C. Onley Award for Leadership in Accessibility.

The award, named after Ontario's 28th Lieutenant Governor, recognizes people that champion accessibility, raise awareness about the benefits of inclusion, and foster positive change in their communities.

The City received a Champion Award for going beyond meeting requirements under the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act to remove barriers in workplaces and communities.
