Contribution Rebate Application

- IMPORTANT:**
- A candidate for an office on municipal council (donating to his/ her own campaign), or their spouse, siblings, grandparents, parents, children and grandchildren are not eligible for a rebate.
 - The maximum contribution permitted per candidate is \$1,200.
 - The maximum rebate an eligible voter may receive on all of their contribution(s) is \$150.
 - A contributor may contribute to more than one candidate’s campaign, but may not make multiple contributions that exceed \$5,000 to candidates for office on the same council or board. Only eligible electors residing in the city of Vaughan are qualified to apply for a rebate. See By-Law 001-2018 for details at vaughan.ca/elections in the Resource Library Section.

To receive a rebate for contributions, the candidate must have elected to participate in the Contribution Rebate Program (see Candidate’s Declaration on receipt). To receive a rebate for a contribution, the contributor must complete and submit this application to the **Office of the City Clerk, City of Vaughan, 2141 Major Mackenzie Dr., Vaughan, ON L6A 1T1**, within 90 days of the candidate’s respective filing deadline. The rebate application deadline for a candidate filing a financial statement by March 29, 2019 is June 27, 2019. Where the candidate’s campaign period is extended because of a deficit, rebate applications must be submitted by Dec. 26, 2019. Candidates must file a financial statement and comply with all requirements of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended, and the City of Vaughan’s By-Law 001-2018, before rebates can be processed.
