Chancellor District Park, adjacent to Community Center and Library Complex – Disruption to playground facilities, shelter and adjacent walkway

November 13, 2017

Construction at Chancellor District Park (430 Chancellor Drive) commenced the week of November 6, 2017 for playground replacement and play precinct revitalization. During this time, the playground facility, splash pad, shelter and section of walkway will be closed.

All other facilities remain open.

Please note there will be temporary interruptions along Chancellor Drive due to delivery of construction material. We ask the public to please use caution and respect the warning signs and fences when present. The facility will reopen to the public fully in Spring 2018.
