

Pet Survival Kit:

- 72 hours of food, bowls, and can opener
- 72 hour supply of water
- Blankets/ towels/ newspaper
- Leash, muzzle, harness
- Litter pan, litter, plastic bags and scooper
- Pet carrier or cage.
- Medical records, especially proof of vaccination.
- Medications and pet first aid kit.
- Current photo of pet incase they become lost, and to prove ownership.
- Information on pets feeding schedule, special instructions or concerns
- List of possible boarding facilities for pet
- ID Tag/ microchip
- Small toy
- Plastic trash bags



After An Emergency

- When you return home, give your pets time to settle back into their routines.
- Leash your pets when they go outside. Familiar landmarks and smells might be gone and your pet can become disoriented and lost.
- The temperament of your pet may change after an emergency, watch them closely. Once friendly animals can become aggressive, or defensive.

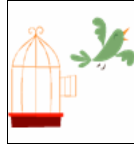
Emergency Preparedness For Pets

What You Need To Know:

- Only service animals are permitted in evacuation centres.
- Your pet's safety is your responsibility before, during, and after an emergency.
- Pets left behind during emergencies can be injured, lost or killed.
- Pets turned loose can become victims of exposure, starvation, predators, or contaminated food or water.
- Pets left inside your residence may escape through damaged areas, such as broken windows.
- Pets left chained or tied outside can be killed or injured.



What You Need To Do :

- Develop a list of pet friendly places. Contact kennels, veterinary facilities hotels, and motels. Learn which hotels, and motels will waive no pet policies in emergencies.
- Put together a pet emergency survival kit.
- When warnings of an impending emergency occur, call and confirm emergency shelter arrangements for your pet.
- If you have to leave a pet behind at home; close and lock all doors and windows, ensure the toilet lid is up, bathroom door wedged open, leave extra bowls of food and water for your pet, ensure animal has ID. Fill out the Pet Record and secure to front door for rescue personnel, if pet rescue becomes available. Also bring a copy of the pet record to the reception centre.
- Bring pets indoors at first indication of an emergency.
- Evacuate with pet immediately
