



**ATTENTION RESIDENTS:**  
***Are you concerned about LEAD  
in your drinking water?***

The Ontario Government revised Regulation 170/03 for Drinking Water Systems to mandate the testing of lead in drinking water at private taps within homes and businesses in Ontario. Long-term exposure to lead is known to cause subtle impairment of learning and intellectual development particularly in those exposed during fetal development or as young children.

The City of Vaughan has implemented a **LEAD TESTING PROGRAM** and requires **volunteers** to allow City staff to take samples for testing. If your home or building was built **before 1991**, you are a candidate. ***Please make an appointment before April 15, 2008.***

If you wish to be part of the testing program, or you have any questions about the program, please contact the City of Vaughan Public Works Department and speak with a water division representative.
