Improvements are underway

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements to various stormwater management facilities and outfall locations. Stormwater management facilities are designed and built to collect rainfall and surface water runoff.

As part of the Capital Works Program, the City is overseeing the construction of a new stormwater management facility at Saddle Tree Crescent Outfall, and the retrofitting of existing stormwater management infrastructure at Accumen Pond. These enhancements support the City's continued commitment to ensuring the long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.

Scope of Work

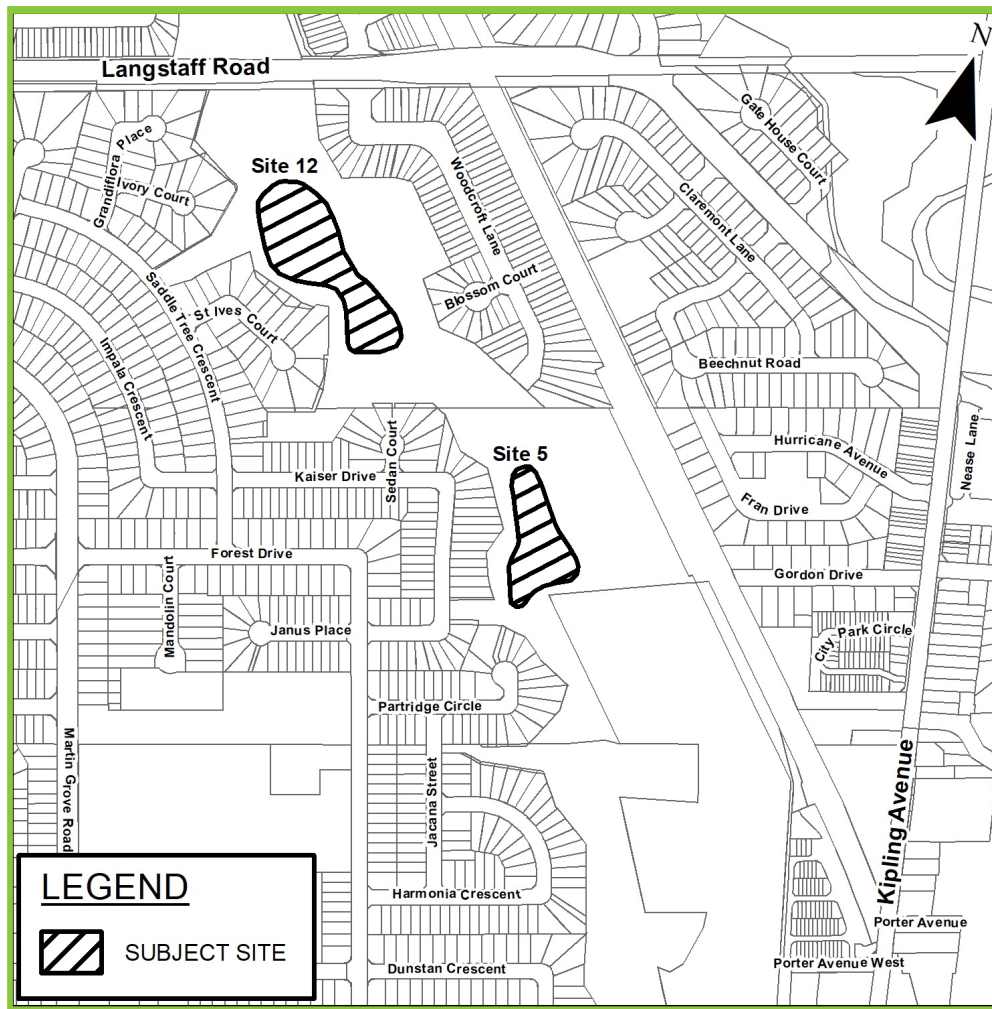
The scope of work includes excavation and grading of the stormwater management ponds and the installation of new stormwater infrastructure adjacent to the sites.

Timelines

Construction has begun with anticipated completion by fall 2023.

Construction Impacts

Roads will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during construction. Temporary traffic diversions will be required at times to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.
