BY-LAW

BY-NUMBER 36-91

A By-law to provide for the use of voting machines, vote recorders, optical scanning vote tabulators or other voting devices at elections.


WHEREAS the Municipal Elections Act, subsection 42a(1) provides that in place of using ballot papers under the said Municipal Elections Act, the Council may now authorize the use, at elections of voting machines, vote recorders, optical scanning and tabulators or other voting devices;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan at its meeting held on October 16, 1990 authorized the use at elections of voting machines, vote recorders, optical scanning vote tabulators or other voting devices;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In place of using ballot papers under the said Municipal Elections Act, voting machines, vote recorders, optical scanning vote tabulators or other voting devices are hereby authorized to be used at all elections governed by the Municipal Elections Act.
2. This By-law is effective for the 1991 regular election and all elections thereafter.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD time and finally passed this 5th day of February 1991.
