



## BATHURST CLARK RESOURCE LIBRARY

In 2016, Vaughan Public Libraries' (VPL) Administration and Business Offices moved from the Bathurst Clark Resource Library (BCRL) to the new Civic Centre Resource Library, allowing BCRL to reclaim space for their customers. This allowed VPL to add approximately 3,000 square feet to the existing children's area. The renovation also provided the opportunity to improve the meeting rooms, interior finishes and washrooms.

As of January 20, 2019, the new children's area has opened to the public. It features a vibrant entrance from the main lobby, story-time area, early literacy computers, digital learning "Learn-It Lab", lounge and study areas.

Within the library, the meeting room renovations are complete and available for public booking. The main library area features new paint and carpet, and a new exterior book return drop box ready for use.

The accessible washrooms were also a major priority for the renovations. As a result, a new universal washroom has opened for public use, and the main washrooms have been upgraded to meet the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA)* standards.

With the major renovation work now finished, the library is ready for all members of the public to partake in and enjoy its new offerings.
