

Stormwater Management Facility Improvements

Project Update

As part of the 2021 Capital Works Program, the City of Vaughan is planning improvements to various Stormwater Management Facility (SWMF) locations. Stormwater management facilities are designed and built to collect rainfall and surface water runoff.

In early 2022, the City will begin the construction work to retrofit the Fieldstone Stormwater Management Pond, located in the vicinity of Jevlan Drive and Chrislea Road. Construction is anticipated to be completed by summer 2022.

Construction Scope

The scope of work includes the cleaning and grading of the Fieldstone Stormwater Management Facility and the construction of access paths and fencing.

Construction Impacts

Roads will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during construction. Temporary traffic diversions will be required at times to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.

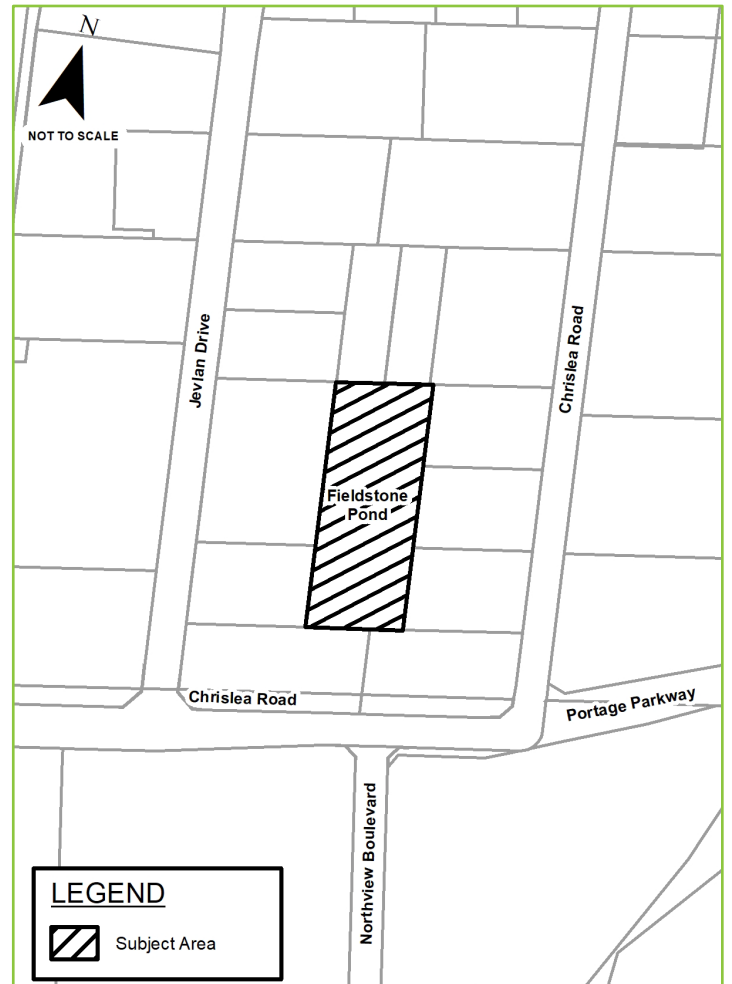
