

RE: WATERMAIN, SEWER AND ROAD RECONSTRUCTION – OLD MAPLE AREA

Local Residents,

The City of Vaughan is hosting two virtual Public Information Centres (PIC) to present plans for infrastructure improvements in the Old Maple area. Work to replace the aging infrastructure, as part of the 2021 Capital Program, includes watermain replacement, as well as storm sewer and road reconstruction.

The virtual sessions will be hosted via Zoom and a presentation about the project will be shared. Citizens will have the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback on the project.

Why attend the virtual Public Information Centre?



About the Project

The City of Vaughan promotes infrastructure renewal projects as key investments that align with Council priorities. Maintaining existing assets in a state of good repair is an important factor driving the public's high satisfaction level with the services provided by the City. The watermain replacement, storm sewer and road reconstruction work for the Old Maple area demonstrates the City's continued commitment to ensuring long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.

Construction is expected to start in spring 2021, with anticipated completion by spring 2022.
