




PMTSA 2 - Rutherford GO Station

The policy text in Chapter 3 prevails over the mapping shown on Schedule 2 in determining the Natural Heritage Network. Core features shall be precisely delineated on a site-by-site basis through the approval of the Planning Act Applications supported by appropriate technical studies. Refinements to the NHN may occur through Secondary Plan or development approval processes and shall be reflected on this schedule without the need for an Official Plan Amendment. The block plan process is a non-statutory process in accordance with the Planning Act.

Where the schedule does not accurately reflect an existing development approval, the schedule may be updated without the need for
