

# Improvements coming to Portage Parkway

The City of Vaughan is making improvements to Portage Parkway, from Applewood Crescent to Jane Street.

#### The work includes:

- widening the road from two to four lanes.
- · relocating underground utilities.
- a watermain replacement.
- storm and sanitary sewer replacements.
- installation of new traffic lights and street lighting.
- new streetscaping with cycling paths and sidewalks on both sides of Portage Parkway.

#### **Timeline**

The detailed design for the project is now complete. The City is working to hire a contractor to undertake the work, which is expected to begin in the fall and is anticipated to be complete by spring 2028.

### **Construction impacts**

- Water service disruptions will be required to safely complete the work. You will be given at least 48 hours' notice about water service disruptions and shutdowns will be scheduled overnight, between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m., where possible.
- Temporary detours will be required to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner. Roads will remain open to local traffic at all times.

#### Reminder for property owners


- Underground systems, such as lawn sprinklers, heated driveways, electrical conduits or landscaping located within City-owned boulevards or property limits, may be impacted by the construction work.
- Removing privately owned underground systems in advance of construction, at the owner's expense, is recommended.
- The City is not responsible for any damages that may occur during construction to privately-owned underground systems within City property limits (Road Allowance By-Law 126-2024).
