



Jane Street Uptown Link Project - Phase 2

The next phase of the City's **Jane Street Uptown Link Project** is scheduled to begin this month. The project includes adding eight kilometres of new in-boulevard cycle tracks, four kilometres of new sidewalks and much more, along Jane Street, from Highway 7 to Teston Road.

Project update

Phase 1 construction, from Highway 7 to Major Mackenzie Drive, is underway and scheduled for completion this fall.

Phase 2 construction, from Major Mackenzie Drive to Teston Road, is set to begin this month and be completed by summer 2026.

The work includes:

- adding new multi-use pathways and separate in-boulevard cycling facilities.
- upgrading transit stops and bus stations.
- repairing damaged sidewalks.
- paving roads in and around four intersections.
- painting pathways, roads and crosswalks.
- upgrading traffic signals, signage, and intersection and driveway entrances to meet the guidelines of the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act*.

Construction impacts

Roads will remain open to vehicles and pedestrians during construction, and driveways will remain accessible. Temporary lane restrictions will be required at times to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.
