

Charles Street culvert replacement

Dear resident.

The City of Vaughan is replacing the culvert along Charles Street, between Thornridge Drive and Arnold Avenue. Construction is scheduled to begin this month and is anticipated to be complete by the end of fall 2025.

Culverts are designed to convey the natural flow of stream water across roadways. Replacing the culvert on Charles Street supports the City's continued commitment to ensuring the long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.

Work will include:

- removing and replacing road asphalt.
- planting trees.
- installing rocks to prevent the banks of the stream from eroding.

To safely complete the work, lane closures will be required along Charles Street. Flag persons and signage will be onsite to guide traffic. Roads will remain accessible to local traffic at all times.
