



Charlton Avenue culvert rehabilitation

Dear resident,

The City of Vaughan is rehabilitating the culvert on Charlton Avenue, between Joseph Aaron Boulevard and Badessa Circle. Construction is scheduled to begin this month and is anticipated to be complete by the end of fall 2025.

Culverts are designed to convey the natural flow of stream water across roadways. Rehabilitating the culvert on Charlton Avenue supports the City's continued commitment to ensuring the long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.

Work will include:

- removing and replacing the road asphalt, concrete curbs and gutters.
- planting trees.
- installing rocks to prevent the banks of the stream from eroding.

To safely complete the work, lane closures will be required on Charlton Avenue. Flag persons and signage will be onsite to guide traffic. Roads will remain accessible to local traffic at all times.
