

East Humber River outfall upgrades

Dear resident,

The City of Vaughan is improving outfalls at sites along the East Humber River, including in Maxey Park (199 Willis Rd.), behind Riverside Drive and at Nattress Street. This work is part of ongoing efforts to improve stormwater management in your area.

Work will include improving the outfall structures – which drain stormwater – and installing erosion protection.

Construction is scheduled to begin this fall and be completed by fall 2026. To complete the work safely and efficiently, lane closures may be required.

Environmental protection

All relevant environmental agencies have been notified of the work. The City is committed to protecting the local environment and will ensure guidelines are followed and all necessary precautions are taken to protect trees, fish, birds and natural habitats.
