

As a place to socialize, picnic and relax




As a place to exercise and be active, through activities like running and biking



COMMUNITY PREFERENCES

The City of Vaughan sought feedback on whether to renew the existing bocce court or replace it with a different amenity that staff have identified as feasible for this location.




Many participants preferred to replace bocce with outdoor fitness, while some preferred to replace it with a new play area or gathering space. Fewer participants were interested in renewing bocce or replacing it with a community garden, and several chose "none of the above."

Through conversations at the Open House and responses to other open-ended survey questions, the City also heard a strong desire for a splashpad instead of the options provided.



Preferred type of equipment




Play area

Preferred style of playground




Preferred age ranges for playground






Gathering space

Preferred location (sun or shade)




Preferred type of seating



When asked how they would use a gathering space at Alexander Elisa Park, participants said they would use it to **socialize** with family and friends, have **picnics** and **gatherings**, **supervise kids** and **relax**. Although many saw the value in having a gathering space, some participants also voiced their concerns about the potential for loitering.

Bocce renewal


Preferred layout

Although most participants were not interested in a community garden, of those who were interested, a collective garden model (where a community service organization or non-profit organization would operate it) was preferred.

ADDITIONAL SUGGESTIONS

The City also sought suggestions for an open area at the south end of the park that could potentially accommodate additional amenities, subject to future budget requests.

- A significant number of participants suggested a splashpad.
- Many participants suggested a shade structure or additional seating.
- Many participants suggested pickleball courts, while many others suggested tennis courts.
- Some participants suggested an additional play area for kids.
- Some participants suggested an off-leash dog area.
- Some participants suggested a ping pong table.
- A few participants suggested a skating rink.
- A few participants suggested a washroom facility.
