



Improving road safety

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Dear resident,

The City of Vaughan is improving road safety in your community with new traffic control measures, including:

- New traffic signals at Beverley Glen Boulevard and Worth Boulevard.
- Removal of the existing Intersection Pedestrian Signal (IPS) between Worth Boulevard and Ventura Way.
- A new controlled pedestrian crossing at Beverley Glen Boulevard and Kingsbridge Circle (across from Thornhill Green Park, located at 19 Beverley Glen Blvd.).

Pre-construction/design activities, including marking the locations of underground utilities – like gas and hydro – with different coloured paint, will begin this fall. Construction is expected to begin in spring/summer 2026.
