

ROAD CLOSURE Kirby Road, from Highway 27 to Kipling Avenue

NOTICE

To ensure Kirby Road remains safe and accessible, the City of Vaughan will be reconstructing the slope – or steep hill – and culvert on this road, just east of Highway 27 between Kipling Avenue.

The work is scheduled to begin on Monday, Sept. 8 and expected to wrap up by the end of this year. To safely complete this work, a road closure is required in the area of construction along Kirby Road, between Highway 27 and Kipling Avenue. Local traffic will have access to Kirby Road throughout construction.

How does this impact you?

During this time, local traffic will have access to Kirby Road. This closure does not impact access to any driveways or homes in this area.

Will detours be put in place?

Yes. Detour routes and signage will be in place to guide traffic at the following intersections:

- Kirby Road and Briarose Avenue/Belsite Court
- Kirby Road and Kleinburg Summit Way
- Kirby Road and Kipling Avenue
- Kipling Avenue and King-Vaughan Road
- Highway 27 and Kirby Road

Why is this section of Kirby Road being improved?

The slope along Kirby Road requires stabilization to prevent erosion and maintain safe road conditions. The existing culvert must also be replaced to ensure effective drainage and prevent road damage.
