## **BY-LAW NUMBER 249-2025**

A By-law of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan to amend Business Licensing By-law 122-2022, as amended, to correct a typographical error.

**AND WHEREAS** subsection 8(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, as amended, ("*Municipal Act*") provides that a by-law under section 10 and 11 of the *Municipal Act* may regulate or prohibit, require persons to do things, and provide for a system of licences respecting a matter;

**AND WHEREAS** subsection 11(3) of the *Municipal Act* sets out that a lower-tier municipality may pass by-laws with respect to business licensing;

**AND WHEREAS** section 151(1) of the *Municipal Act* provides that a municipality may provide for a system of licences with respect to a business;

**AND WHEREAS** Council has determined that it is desirable to make a technical amendment to Business Licensing By-law 122-2022, as amended;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Business Licensing By-law 122-2022, as amended, be further amended as follows:
  - a. In Schedule "A" to replace the words "Private Garages (Owner)" with "Public Garages (Owner)" and to place the amended term in alphabetical order within the schedule.
