Construction timelines

Road construction is expected to begin by May 2026 and is anticipated to be completed by fall 2026.

Construction impacts

- Roads will remain open to vehicles and pedestrians during construction.
- To complete the work safely and efficiently, temporary lane restrictions will be required.
- Access to private and commercial driveways and entrances will occasionally be impacted.
- If you have limited mobility and require accommodation to access your property during construction activities, please contact the City's Infrastructure Delivery department.

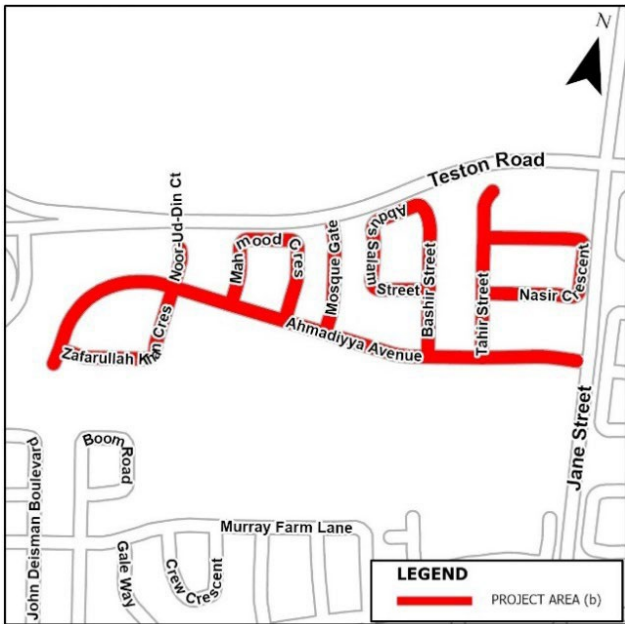
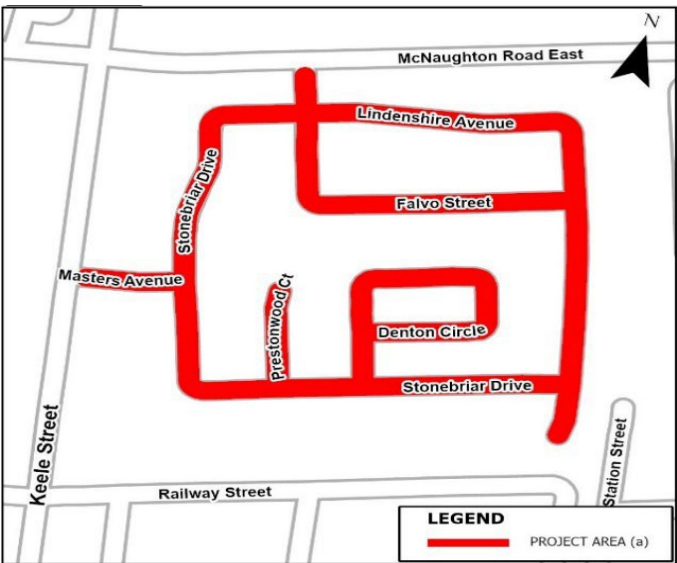
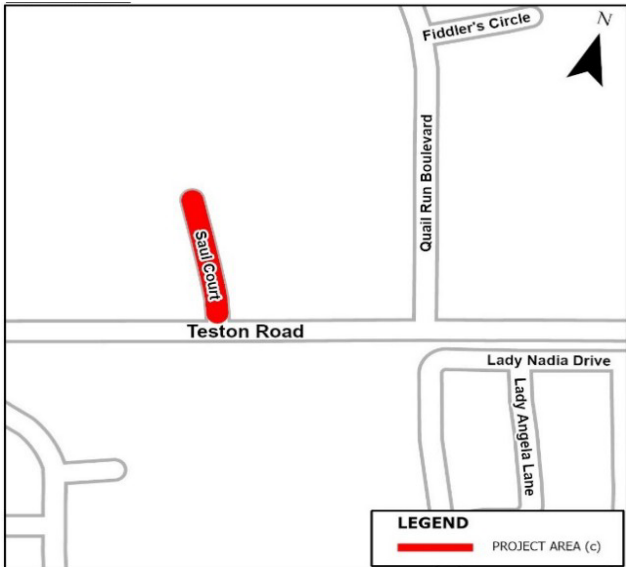
Reminders for property owners

- Under the Road Allowance By-Law 126-2024, the City is not responsible for damage that may occur during construction to privately-owned items located on City property, including underground systems like lawn sprinklers, heated driveways and landscaping.
- Removing privately-owned underground systems, at the owner's expense, is recommended before work begins.
- If you have landscape or driveway work planned for 2026, please contact the City's Infrastructure Delivery department to learn how the scheduled work could impact your property.
