



Watermain upgrades on Lindenshire Avenue

Dear resident,

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important infrastructure improvements on Lindenshire Avenue, from Stonebriar Drive to Simcoe Street, including the pedestrian pathway connecting Lindenshire Avenue and Simcoe Street.

Work will include upgrading the existing watermain system and replacing streetlights. Concrete sidewalks, curbs and asphalt roadway will be removed and replaced in the work area as part of the City's 2026 Pavement Management Program.

Pre-construction/design activities, including marking the locations of underground utilities, has commenced in your neighbourhood. Construction is scheduled to begin in the spring and be completed in July 2026.

To safely and efficiently complete the work, temporary lane restrictions will be in place and the pedestrian pathway connecting Lindenshire Avenue and Simcoe Street will be closed until the project is finished. Signs and barriers will be in place to guide drivers and pedestrians.

Access to select driveways may be impacted during the watermain replacement. Residents will be given 48-hours' notice of the work.
