Dear resident,

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements in Ward 5 as part of the **2026 Pavement Management Program**. Work will include restoring community roads and repairing curbs and sidewalks. Construction is expected to begin by May and is anticipated to be completed by this fall.

The following roads will be impacted:

- Bayhampton Crescent
- Briarcliffe Crescent
- Chelwood Drive
- Highcliffe Drive
- Judith Avenue
- Samuel Oster Avenue
- Westcroft Avenue

Frequently asked questions

The contractor installed new sod on my lawn. Who is responsible for the maintenance?

The contractor is responsible for watering and maintaining the new sod. However, residents are encouraged to water it frequently to ensure root growth and healthy green grass.

My driveway is blocked due to the work. Will I get a parking ticket if I park on the roadway?

The City's By-law department has been instructed not to issue tickets in the construction area. However, if you are parked contrary to the posted parking prohibitions, or the provisions of the City's Parking By-law 064-2019, you may be ticketed. For more information, visit vaughan.ca/bylaw.

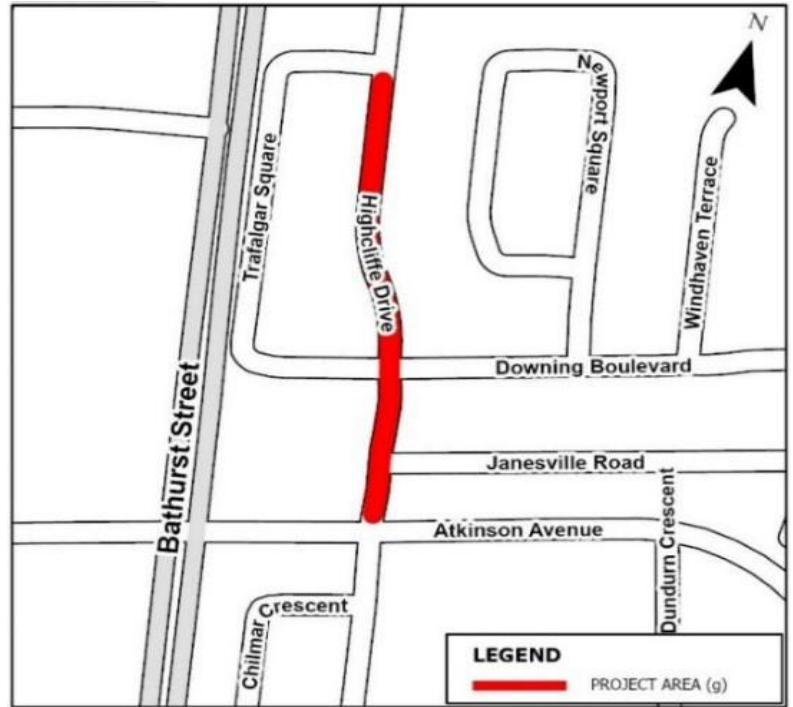
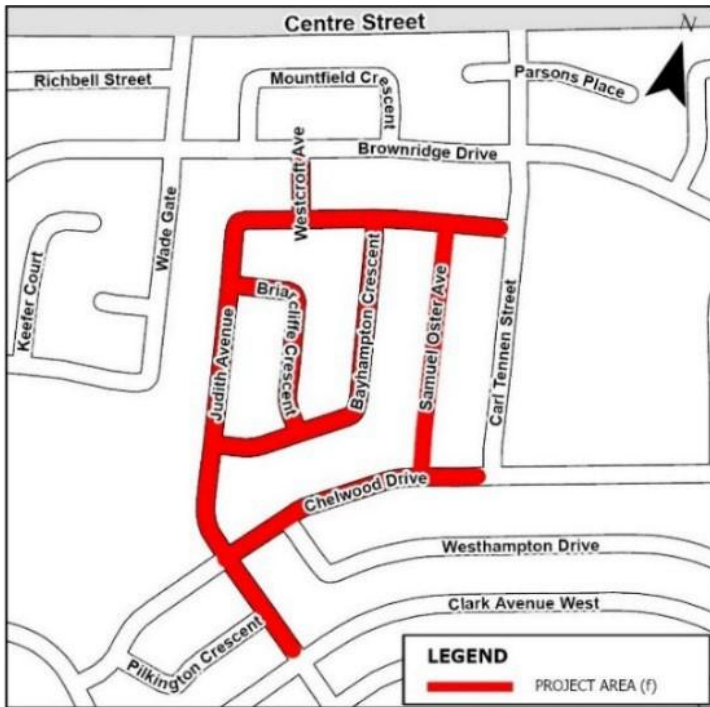
