



Jane Street Uptown Link project

UPDATE | MAY 2026

Dear resident/business owner,

The City of Vaughan is paving Jane Street at Norwood Avenue and Avro Road as part of the Jane Street Uptown Link project. Weather permitting, lane reductions and partial intersection closures are required on Jane Street between Springside Road and Major Mackenzie Drive on weekdays from **Monday, May 11 to Tuesday, May 19, between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.**

Construction impacts

Construction may result in instances of excessive noise in the area. Jane Street will remain open to traffic, and all residential driveways will remain accessible. However, access to and from Norwood Avenue and Avro Road may be temporarily impacted by the work. Traffic control and detour signs will be in place.

About the project

The Jane Street Uptown Link is an Active Transportation Facility (ATF) that was identified as an important infrastructure improvement in the City's Pedestrian and Bicycle Master Plan. The project offers connections to the Vaughan Metropolitan Centre, Vaughan Mills, Canada's Wonderland and more than 500 businesses along Jane Street.

The Jane Street Uptown Link aims to improve pedestrian and cyclist safety along Jane Street by building a new cycle track, connecting missing sidewalk links, improving streetlighting, and upgrading intersections and traffic signals between Highway 7 and Teston Road.
