



Canada Drive-America Avenue Bridge

The City of Vaughan is undertaking intersection improvements at John Deisman Boulevard and America Avenue as part of the Canada Drive-America Avenue Bridge project.

Construction is scheduled to take place **from Monday, June 8 to Sunday, June 21**, weather permitting. To safely and efficiently complete the work, the following road closures will be in place during this time:

- John Deisman Boulevard, between Bluewater Trail and Convoy Crescent
- America Avenue, between Journal Avenue and John Deisman Boulevard

Detour routes and signage will be in place to guide vehicle and pedestrian traffic at the following intersections:

- John Deisman Boulevard and Mainland Crescent/Murray Farm Lane
- John Deisman Boulevard and Ferdinand Avenue
- America Avenue and Boom Road/Windy Way

The closure will not impact access to driveways or homes in the area.

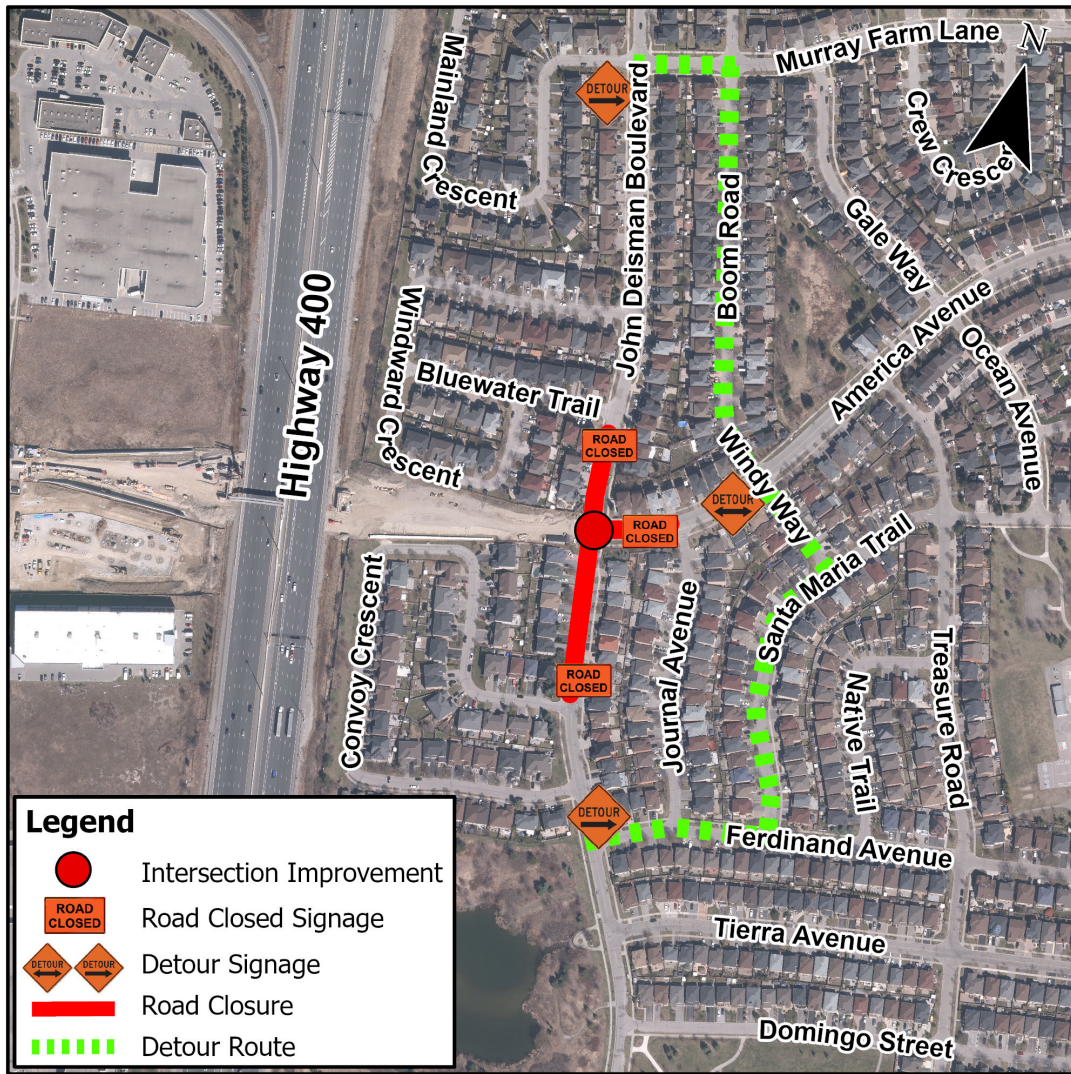
About the project
