Dear resident,

The City of Vaughan is improving road safety in your community with new traffic control measures, including:

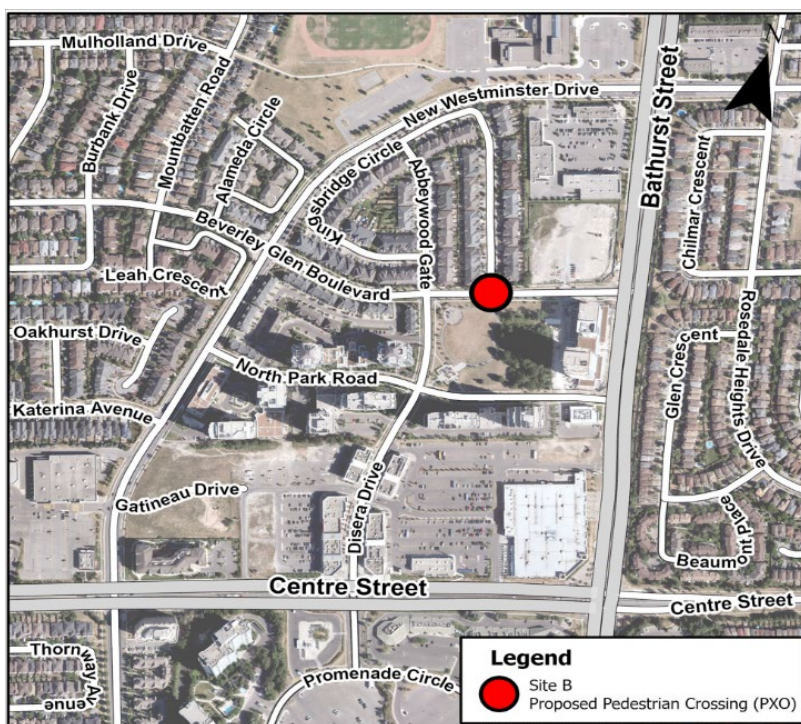
- new traffic signals at Beverley Glen Boulevard and Worth Boulevard.
- removal of the existing Intersection Pedestrian Signal (IPS) between Worth Boulevard and Ventura Way.
- a new controlled pedestrian crossing at Beverley Glen Boulevard and Kingsbridge Circle (across from Thornhill Green Park, located at 19 Beverley Glen Blvd.).

Construction is scheduled to begin this month and is anticipated to be complete this fall, site and weather conditions permitting.

During this time, pedestrian access through the work area may be temporarily restricted. For your safety, please follow all posted construction signage and directions from on-site personnel.
