

Water service disruption due to emergency water main repairs Friday, Aug. 27, 2021 at 1 a.m.

The City of Vaughan will be completing emergency water main repairs starting at 1 a.m. on Friday, Aug. 27. To limit the impact on residents and businesses, the work is scheduled overnight. To complete the work safely and efficiently, water to the area must be shut off.

The following areas will be impacted from **Friday, Aug. 27, at 1 a.m. to approximately 6 a.m.**, pending there are no major delays.

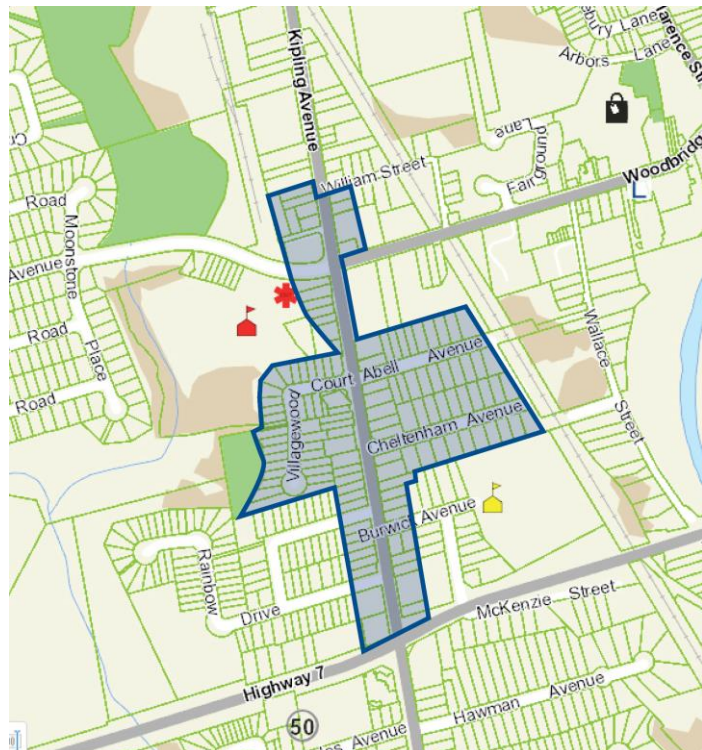

- Abell Avenue
- Cheltenham Avenue

When water service is restored, residents may notice air in pipes and water may be discoloured. This is normal and if it occurs, run cold water for a few minutes to get rid of the air and colour.
