

# NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

## York Peel Feedermain Rehabilitation

In the City of Vaughan

February 2, 2022

The Regional Municipality of York is working in the community rehabilitating a section of the York Peel Feedermain located at Highway 27 and Rutherford Road. The rehabilitation work is required to extend the life of the feedermain and make sure critical water services are continually provided to the community.



**When?** Work on the feedermain has begun and is expected to be completed by spring 2022

### What Can You Expect?

- There will be lane restrictions at the intersection of Highway 27 and Rutherford Road that may cause periodic traffic delays. Directional signage will be posted, and staff will be on-site, as needed, to help with the movement of traffic and reduce any delays.
- The rehabilitation work requires the crews to work extended hours on site, up to 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Every effort to minimize any disruption will be made.
- Temporary sidewalks will be installed near the work area at Highway 27 and Rutherford Road. Directional signage will be in place to help guide pedestrians around the sidewalk closures.
- York Region Transit (YRT) service will be maintained. Riders are encouraged to visit [yrt.ca](http://yrt.ca) or call 1-866-668-3978 with any questions about the service or schedule.
- Due to the nature of the work, there will be some construction-related noise and dust from the equipment and trucks, though every effort to minimize this will be made.
- Access to all homes and buildings will be maintained.
- There is no planned impact to your water or wastewater services.

Thank you for your patience while we complete this vital work. As with all construction projects, some work may be re-scheduled due to weather or other conditions.
