Construction and temporary traffic diversion — Arnold Avenue, from Brooke Street to Yonge Street

Monday, Aug. 8 at 7 a.m. to Monday, Sept. 12 at 5 p.m.

Due to sewer construction (weather permitting), access to Arnold Avenue, from Brooke Street to Yonge Street, will be limited to local traffic only from Monday, Aug. 8 at 7 a.m. to Monday, Sept. 12 at 5 p.m.

This necessary municipal infrastructure work – to install a new storm sewer on Arnold Avenue from Brooke Street to west of Yonge Street – requires a temporary road occupancy on Arnold Avenue to complete the work as safely and efficiently as possible.

In the event of inclement weather or unfavourable site conditions, the temporary traffic diversion and work will be rescheduled and/or extended as required.

Please note:

- Some construction may take place overnight to complete the work safely and to minimize disruption to the community
- Traffic detours will be in place during the work, with access limited to local traffic only on Arnold Avenue

This work will be carried out by the City-retained contractor, DPSSL Group Ltd., under the direction of the City's Infrastructure Delivery department.
