Temporary Right-turn Restrictions and Lane Reductions — Langstaff Road, at the intersection of Keele Street

Starting Sunday, Oct. 23 at 7:00 p.m., for approximately one week

Due to watermain construction on Keele Street, from Jardin Drive to Langstaff Road, temporary westbound right-turn restrictions and lane reductions will be in place within the intersection of Langstaff Road and Keele Street, starting Sunday, Oct. 23 at 7 p.m.

This necessary municipal infrastructure work – to install new watermains on Keele Street – requires **temporary right-turn restrictions for trucks, from westbound Langstaff Road to northbound Keele Street**, to complete the work as safely and efficiently as possible as well as to minimize disruption to traffic.

Please note:

- Traffic detours will be in place during the work to direct truck traffic accordingly (refer to enclosed map)
- **The lane reductions and associated turning restrictions will begin on Sunday, Oct. 23 at 7:00 p.m. and are expected to be in place for approximately one week**

This work will be carried out by the City-retained contractor, Four Season Site Development Limited, under the direction of the City's Infrastructure Delivery department.
