Temporary Facility Closures – Matthew Park Splash Pad

June 14, 2019

Please be advised that the water play facility at Matthew Park will be closed starting Monday, June 17th until Wednesday, June 19th. The water play facilities will reopen on Thursday, June 20th. The purpose of the closure is to allow for the installation of concrete works at the drainage area which is shared by both the splash pad and playground. The concrete was initially removed to connect drainage pipes from the playground area to the existing catch basin.

Please note there will be temporary interruptions along adjacent roads due to delivery of construction material as the construction for the playground continues. We ask the public to please use caution and respect the warning signs and fences when present.
