Vaughan is rolling ahead with new bike paths on Clark Avenue

To help people move more comfortably around the Thornhill community, the City of Vaughan is installing 4.5 kilometres of bike paths on both sides of Clark Avenue, between Jason Street/David Lewis Drive and Yonge Street. The project is funded in part by the Province of Ontario and York Region.

You are receiving this notification because the installation of the bike paths will take place near your home/business. Construction will begin in June 2020 and the cycling facilities will be substantially completed by December of this year. The road rehabilitation phase will be completed in the spring/summer of 2021.

Vaughan is committed to supporting sustainable and healthy active living. Bike riding contributes to this as it has significant health, environmental, economic and social benefits. The Thornhill community is part of the City's SNAP project to make older neighbourhoods more sustainable.

In addition to the new bike paths, the project includes improvements to public transit stops in the area, as well as intersection and road upgrades that will help create easier and more efficient ways for people to bike, walk and drive through this vibrant community.

Roads will remain open during construction. Temporary lane restrictions will allow construction activities to proceed in an efficient manner. Access to private and commercial driveways and entrances may be impacted during construction. Work in these areas will happen during off-peak hours to minimize disruptions.

The City of Vaughan has retained Four Seasons Site Development Ltd. to facilitate the construction. The City appreciates your co-operation and patience as we work to construct the bike paths, transit and road improvements as efficiently as possible.
