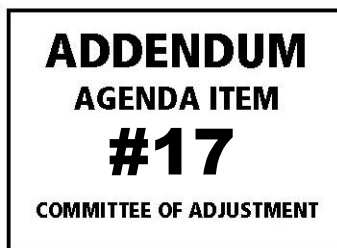

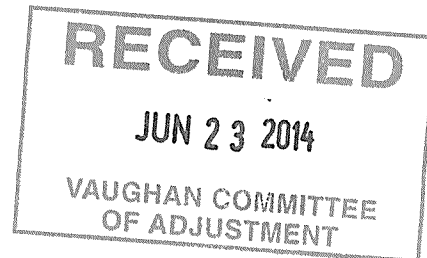

Anita and I have been residing in this neighbourhood since 1984 following completion of a 2 years task of addition and renovation of our home. We are very grateful to the great work of the City in improving and maintaining the unique characteristics of the neighbourhood and would also like to welcome the Schcolyar.

After discussion with our neighbour, Gordon Foss who also has provided me a copy of the plan of the future home of the Schcolyar, we like to express my objection to all the four proposals to allow for variances in height and sideyards. My reasons are as followed:

First, a beautiful home which should be in a 150' lot would be out of place in a 100' lot and violates the characteristics of our neighbourhood.

Secondly, the excess height and proximity would have an impact on both the Foss on the south and the Smith on the north side as it is too imposing and blocks sunlight negatively impacting on their sense of space, garden and swimming pool.

In summary, we request support of all members of the Committee to turn down the application as it would be too imposing on the existing neighbours on both sides.
