Tax receipts will be issued for donations of \$25 or more. RecAssist was established and approved by Vaughan Council in January 2009 and is administered by Recreation Services.

To qualify for RecAssist

1. You must be a resident of Vaughan and provide proof of City of Vaughan residency via a copy of a property tax bill, utility bill, driver's license or similar documentation with your address.
2. Have a combined total family income less than the Low Income Cut-offs (LICO).
3. Download and submit a completed **RecAssist Application Form** with the previous year's income tax return (Notice of Assessment) attached for all income sources.
4. Complete your own application if you are over 18 years of age.

Unclaimed credit balances are donated to RecAssist.

Every year, during the month of April, Recreation Services reviews all credit balances on client accounts. Clients who have an unclaimed credit that is two years or older are notified by mail and given the option to request a refund or donate their credit to RecAssist.

RecAssist is funded solely through fundraisers and generous donations, including unclaimed credits. All proceeds go directly towards program registration, with Recreation Services covering all administration costs.

To donate your unclaimed credit no response is required—thank you for your generosity!
