Re: City of Vaughan Water Distribution System Confirmation of Water Quality

The City of Vaughan operates its Water Distribution System in compliance with the Safe Drinking Water Act (2002) for the Province of Ontario. This Act requires that the City provide potable water to all homes, as well as to industrial, commercial and institutional users connected to the system.

The Ontario Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) is the regulator that oversees the safe operation of the drinking water system through annual inspections, audits and reporting mechanisms. The City of Vaughan is required to prepare an annual report and annual summary report documenting the safe operation of the system. These reports are filed with the ministry and presented to Vaughan Council. Electronic copies of these reports are available on the City's website at:
