

Nashville Cemetery Company Fonds

TITLE: Nashville Cemetery Company fonds
DATES: 1912-1971
EXTENT: 27 cm of textual records [includes ca. 500 items]
BIO & ADMIN HIST: The Nashville Cemetery Company was formed in 1912 by 14 local investors in connection with the Zoar Primitive Methodist Church Cemetery in Nashville, ON. From 1912-1971, the cemetery was administered by the Company. In 1971, the Town of Vaughan assumed the function.

SCOPE & CONTENT: The fonds consists of plot indexes, deeds, a burial register, financial records, minutes of the Nashville Cemetery Plot Owners Association, minutes of the Company's shareholders, correspondence and a perpetual care fund. The fonds also consists of 3 oversize plot plans with names of Internees (1914, [ca.1965], n.d.).
