

**Vaughan Township Abstract Indexes to Deeds
and Land Registry Copy Books Fonds**

TITLE: Vaughan Township Abstract Indexes to Deeds and land registry copy books fonds [microform] : [1788-1958]. -- Microfilmed [ca. 1985].

BIO & ADMIN HIST: Beginning in 1865 all documents and instruments relating to land ownership and encumbrances in each municipality were required to be registered at full length in land registry copy books, with memorials (abstracts) called abstract indexes of deeds entered in separate ledgers. Transactions in copy books are in chronological sequence, with entries in the abstract indexes made under separate headings for each individual lot or part thereof as originally patented by the Crown and every instrument concerning such lots identified by registration number, date, etc.. In effect, these abstract indexes provide a capsule history of land ownership for each lot or segment in the Township.
