3 CAPITAL BUDGET AMENDMENT AND AWARD OF TENDER T15-038 - SUPPLY AND <u>DELIVERY OF LIGHT DUTY VEHICLES</u>

The Finance, Administration and Audit Committee recommends approval of the recommendation contained in the following report of the Deputy City Manager of Public Works, dated January 11, 2016:

Recommendation

The Deputy City Manager of Public Works, in consultation with the Director of Purchasing Services and the Director of Financial Planning & Development Finance and Deputy City Treasurer, recommends:

- 1. That Part A and B of Tender T15-038 Supply and Delivery of Light Duty Vehicles be awarded to Barrie Chrysler Dodge Jeep Ram Ltd. in the amount of \$916,672.00 (Part A \$418,160.00, Part B \$498,512.00) plus provisional items in the amount of \$100,100.00 and any applicable taxes;
- That Part C, D and E of Tender T15-038 Supply and Delivery of Light Duty Vehicles be awarded to East Court Ford Lincoln Ltd. in the amount of \$310,911.30 (Part C- \$120,777.30, Part D - \$164,565.00 and Part E - \$25,569.00) plus provisional items of \$240,929.00 and any applicable taxes;
- 3. That Council approve the addition of supplemental Bluetooth, rear-camera, extended roof height provisions for improved operator safety and operational accessory needs;
- 4. That the above award amounts including all provisional items, taxes and administrative recovery be funded from the approved capital project budgets as outlined in Attachment #1;
- 5. That the approved capital project budgets be amended as outlined in Attachment #1 with a net capital budget increase of \$66,414.00 to be funded from the Vehicle Replacement Reserve and \$4,722.00 to be funded from the City-Wide Development Charges Fleet Reserve to fund the added safety features outlined above:
- 6. That the inclusion of this matter on a Public Committee or Council agenda with respect to increasing the capital budgets as outlined in Attachment #1 is deemed sufficient notice pursuant to Section 2(1)(c) of By-Law 394-2002 as amended; and
- 7. That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign the necessary documents.

Economic Impact

A total of forty-six (46) units are being purchased with funding from 2014 and 2015 approved capital projects as outlined in Attachment #1. An overall capital budget amendment of \$71,135.00 is required to fund provisions for added safety features such as Bluetooth, rear-cameras and extended roof height as well as operational accessories such as plow and salt spreader attachments as required in the approved capital projects.

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The capital project budget increases are outlined in Attachment #1, with \$66,414.00 to be funded from the Vehicle Replacement Reserve and \$4,722.00 to be funded from City-Wide Development Charges Fleet Reserve.

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to recommend that Part A and B of Tender T15-038 Supply and delivery of Light Duty Vehicles, be awarded to Barrie Chrysler Dodge Jeep Ram Ltd. in the amount of \$916,672.00 plus provisional items of \$100,100.00 and any applicable taxes and Part C, D and E of Tender T15-038 - Supply and Delivery of Light Duty Vehicles be awarded to East Court Ford Lincoln Ltd. in the amount of \$310,911.30 plus provisional items of \$240,929.00 and any applicable taxes.

Background - Analysis and Options

Subject bid Advertisement was posted on City website, Biddingo & OPBA on October 1, 2015, with the closing date of October 16, 2015. One (1) Addendum issued to answer questions received. Nine (9) potential bidders picked up the documents and four (4) bidders submitted bids. Upon review bids from following two (2) bidders are declared compliant:

- 1. Barrie Chrysler Dodge
- 2. East Court Lincoln
- 3. Donway Ford Sales
- 4. Durham Chrysler Dodge

Staff have reviewed the bids for mathematical errors and are satisfied the lowest bidders meets the specifications. The award does not exactly match the bids submitted due to a variance in number of trucks purchased and procurement of provisional items.

Total provisional items of \$100,100 in Part A and B include Bluetooth and rear-camera features on all vehicles for improved safety as well as operational accessory needs such as 4x4 and plow and salt spreader attachments where required to meet the vehicle specifications in the approved capital projects.

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Total provisional items of \$240,929 in Part C, D and E include the same added safety features such as Bluetooth and rear-camera on all vehicles as well as extended roof height on cargo vans and operational accessories required to meet project specifications. In addition, Part E provisions include \$204,552 for 8 additional vehicles for Building Standards. These vehicles were included as provisional items in the bid document as capital funding had not been approved at the time the bid was released. Council approval for the procurement of these 8 vehicles was received on November 17, 2015.
