BY-LAW NUMBER 076-2022

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan to amend the temporary use By-law 094-2020, as amended, to change the time frame for the temporary use of land, buildings or structures within the City of Vaughan to accommodate outdoor distancing measures with respect to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 and Section 39 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, ("Planning Act") to authorize the temporary use of land, buildings or structures which otherwise is prohibited; and;

WHEREAS Council of the City of Vaughan has provided adequate information to the

public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the Planning Act; and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS

FOLLOWS:

- That By-law 094-2020, as amended, be further amended by adding the words "and By-law 001-2021" after the word "By-law 1-88" in sections 1.a) and 1.b).
- 2. That By-law 094-2020, as amended, be further amended by repealing Section1.d) and replacing it with the following:

The provisions of this By-law shall apply to the lands within the boundaries of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan as shown on the attached Schedule '1' until January 1, 2023.
