# ***BY-LAW***

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 085-2015**

**A By-law to further amend By-law Number 1-96 to govern and control the parking, placing and stopping of motor vehicles in the City of Vaughan.**

WHEREAS on April 21, 2015 the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan adopted the recommendations of Report 17 of the Committee of the Whole (Item E30) to revise the City of Vaughan Parking By-law 1-96, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law Number 1-96, as amended (hereinafter “the Parking By-law”) is hereby amended by deleting the definition of “Boulevard” in Section 2(1) and replacing it with the following definition:  
“that part of a public street or highway that is not used, or intended to be used, for vehicle travel by the general public, and is situated between the travelled portion of the road and the adjoining property line.”
2. The Parking By-law is hereby amended by deleting the definition of “Highway” in Section 2(1) and replacing it with the following definition:  
“includes a common and public highway, any part of which is intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles and pedestrians and includes the area between the property lines thereof.”

3. The Parking By-law is hereby amended by adding the following new definitions in Section 2(1):  
“Driveway means an approved, paved vehicular access-way providing access from a public highway to a building or property, loading space, an approved parking area or garage, and does not include a public sidewalk.”  
“Street includes that part of a highway used or intended to be used for vehicular travel by the general public.”
4. The Parking By-law is hereby amended by adding the following Section 4(6)(i):  
“on any portion of the boulevard, but does not include the approved/legal portion of a driveway.”
5. The Parking By-law is hereby amended by deleting in Section 4(7)(c), “six (6)” and replacing it with “0.6”.
6. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the date it is enacted by City Council.
