In recognition of the ethnic diversity of the residents of a municipality the City of Vaughan will fly at the Vaughan City Hall the flag of any nation, country or ethnic group on the national day or on the anniversary of a special occasion, upon written request to the City Clerk submitted one month in advance by that nation, or ethnic group or its representatives; and

If the event, campaign or declaration is directly related to matters over which the City has jurisdiction or the City directly sponsors the event, campaign or other matter".

On October 25, 2010, Bill 103 was passed by the Legislature of the Province of Ontario declaring June as Italian Heritage Month. This event promotes and celebrates the diversity of the residents of the City of Vaughan, and a significant portion of the community is expected to participate. Council has previously granted this request.
