BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 186-2012

A By-law to amend By-law 371-2004 being a by-law to provide for the issuing, revoking, and/or suspending of permits and for regulating and inspecting filming events within the City of Vaughan.

WHEREAS section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001,* S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended (the "*Municipal Act, 2001*"), provides that the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate, and to enhance its ability to respond to municipal issues.

AND WHEREAS section 11(3) and Part IV of the Municipal Act, 2001 provide that a municipality

may pass By-laws and provide for a system of licenses regulating business licensing

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan, after holding a public meeting on December 10, 2012 to consider public input on proposed amendments, has determined that it is desirable to make amendments to the Filming By-law 371-2004, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council for The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That Section 3.0 (3) (a) of the By-law be amended by deleting "of five hundred dollars (\$500.00);" and substituting the following therefore:" as set out in schedule A"
- 2. That Bylaw 371-2004 is amended by adding "Schedule A" attached hereto.
- 3. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the date of enactment
