**PROCLAMATION REQUEST
CHILDREN'S MENTAL HEALTH WEEK**

The Committee of the Whole recommends approval of the recommendation contained in the following report of the City Clerk, dated April 29, 2014:

Recommendation

The City Clerk recommends:

1. That May 4 – 10, 2014 be proclaimed as “Children’s Mental Health Week”;
2. That the proclamation be posted on the City’s website and published on the City Page Online; and
3. That Council ratify the action taken.

The Corporate Communications Department posts proclamations issued by the City on the City’s website under “Council – Proclamations” and on the City Page Online.

Purpose

To respond to the correspondence received from the Chairperson of The York Centre for Children, Youth & Families, dated April 7, 2014, requesting that May 4 – 10, 2014 be proclaimed as “Children’s Mental Health Week”.

Background - Analysis and Options

The correspondence received from the Chairperson of The York Centre for Children, Youth & Families, dated April 7, 2014, is attached as Attachment 1. This request was received too late to be placed on the last Council meeting. The next Council meeting is on May 6, 2014 and due to the time-sensitivity of the proclamation, we respectfully request that this report be approved and that Council ratify the action taken.

The proclamation request meets the City’s Proclamation Policy, as follows:

“That upon request, the City of Vaughan issue Proclamations for events, campaigns or other similar matters:

- (i) which are promoted by any organization that is a registered charity pursuant to Section 248 of the Income Tax Act”

The York Centre for Children, Youth & Families is a children’s mental health agency which provides services across York Region. One in 5 children experiences mental health problems and frequently these problems are not diagnosed or treated and may become more serious.
