ADMINISTRATIVE BUDGET ADJUSTMENT

PK-6305-15 NORTH MAPLE REGIONAL PARK PHASE 1 - WARD 1

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Planning in consultation with the Director of Parks Development, Director of Transportation Services & Parks and Forestry Operations and the Director of Financial Planning & Analytics, recommends:

- That the scope of work for Phase 1 implementation of North Maple Regional Park be amended to include the development of two artificial turf fields with funding for the second field provided by a transfer from the Keele Valley Reserve as previously approved by Council and outlined in this report;
- 2. That the proposed contribution of \$150,000 from the Vaughan Soccer Club towards the development of soccer facilities to support the Long Term Player Development program requirements be recognized on the project detail sheet and that the Vaughan Soccer Club be thanked for their generous contribution to this project; and,
- 3. That revised detail sheet Attachment 1 for PK-6305-15 North Maple Regional Park Phase 1 be received to replace the one previously submitted for consideration in the 2015 budget.

Background

Council at its September 9, 2014 meeting, adopted the following recommendation from the Finance, Administration and Audit Committee meeting of September 3, 2014 (Item 1, Report 9).

 That once all commitments have been satisfied, that the balance of the funds in the Streetscape Phase 6 and 7 Capital Project PK-6130-07 be returned to the Keele Valley Reserve, and that the Keele Valley Reserve funds be used to fund a second artificial turf field in Phase 1 of the North Maple Park Plan when the capital costs for the second field are presented during the 2015 budget process.

Capital Project Funding

Funding in the amount of \$900,014 for the second artificial turf field can be transferred to North Maple Regional Park Phase 1 Capital Project PK-6305-15 from the remaining funding of \$697,835 from

PK-6130-07 and through an additional withdrawal of \$202,179 from the Keele Valley Reserve as illustrated below.

The remaining balance of the Keele Valley Landfill Reserve will be approximately \$66,000 after the 2015 proposed project and additional reserve withdrawal for the second artificial turf as illustrated in the table below.

The funding for the second artificial turf field will come from the funding being returned from Project PK-6130-07, as shown above, along with an additional withdrawal from the Keele Valley Reserve. This is shown in the table below.

Project Scope of Work

At the January 23, 2015 meeting of the Finance, Administration and Audit Committee various aspects of the North Maple Regional Park Phase 1 project were discussed including the possibility, as proposed by staff, of reducing the project scope of work to only include one artificial turf field, in an effort to reduce 2015-2018 taxation funding requirements. Following this meeting and upon further review and discussion by staff, it was determined that delaying construction of the second artificial turf field would not yield significant savings as deferral of the second field would result in additional project costs associated with tendering, project administration, contractor mobilization and associated costs of undertaking a second separate project. Deferral of the second field would also delay the provision of much needed sports fields to Vaughan user groups and residents. Based on this, it is proposed that the scope of work for Phase 1 be confirmed to include development of the second artificial turf field as discussed and considered by Council in September of 2014.

Operating Costs

Operating costs associated with artificial turf fields were also discussed at the January 23rd meeting. Staff reviewed costs for the maintenance and operation of existing fields and confirm that the annual maintenance costs per artificial field are in the range of \$18,000 for standard level of service items including inspections, field turf maintenance and grooming, fencing, goal post and bench repairs and litter pick-up. Operating costs associated with Phase 1 development at North Maple Regional Park are identified in the budget forecast to correspond with the timing of the park coming into service. Annual contributions to the Artificial Soccer Turf Reserve to fund the future lifecycle replacement of the field turf are made annually based on the incremental revenue earned at the artificial turf field versus a senior natural grass field.

Vaughan Soccer Club Contribution

In addition to the above, on February 4, 2015 the Vaughan Soccer Club (VSC) confirmed with staff their support for the Phase 1 project at North Maple Regional Park with a proposed contribution of \$150,000 to be used to provide additional soccer facilities to meet the requirements of the Long Term Player Development (LTPD) program (such as provision of change rooms, spectator seating, etc.). A letter of support from the VSC is included as Attachment 2. Subject to Council approval of the Phase 1 project, staff from the Parks Development Department will work with the VSC during the design phase of the project to determine the details of the proposed facility upgrades to be completed using the contribution funding. Operating costs associated with these facility improvements, if any, will be determined through the design process.

Conclusion

Based on the foregoing analysis, the detail sheet for Capital Project PK-6305-15 that was submitted as part of Report No. 2, Item 2 of the January 12, 2015 Finance, Administration and Audit Committee is proposed to be revised as shown in Attachment 1 to reflect the identified funding amendments.
