
# **Operations**

Q3 – favourable \$1.2M






#### **Operations – Revenue Variance**




- Overall revenue was \$0.7M less than planned


# **Operations – Expenditure Variance**




- Overall expenditures were \$1.8M less than planned
- Department expenditures are trending 4% lower than planned



#### Water/Wastewater/Stormwater





- Water, Wastewater and Stormwater operations were \$1.6 million unfavourable
- Sales revenues increased slightly due to higher consumption offset by a resultant increase in water and wastewater treatment costs
- Favourable expenses primarily due to lower than expected contracted services, professional fees and position vacancies
