LICENSING OF LOUNGES/NIGHT CLUBS

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE (1) - Tuesday, November 22, 2022

On November 22, 2022, the City of Vaughan Committee of the Whole (1) will consider and receive input from the public on a staff report that proposes to amend the City's Business Licensing By-law to introduce a licence for lounges/night clubs. Proposed amendments to the Licensing By-law include:

- 1. requiring all lounges/nightclubs to be licensed and to comply with zoning requirements;
- 2. requiring all lounges/night clubs to provide security guards;
- 3. requiring all lounges/night clubs to have and use metal detectors;
- 4. requiring all lounges/night clubs to install and operate high-definition security cameras;
- 5. requiring all lounges/night clubs to have and follow noise attenuation, litter mitigation and crowd control plans; and
- 6. requiring all lounges/night clubs to keep points of egress free of any obstructions.
