

FENCE BY-LAW EXEMPTION APPLICATION

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

<u>Fence By-law 189-2020</u> as amended, posted in the <u>By-law Library</u>, regulates fence height, materials, swimming pool enclosures and other fence standards in the City of Vaughan. If you would like to build a fence that is not in compliance with the Fence By-law, you can submit this application requesting permission to do so, with the required fee. Staff will then review your request and advise whether your request has been granted or refused.

How to submit this application

To apply, persons must submit a completed application and pay the applicable fee as listed at https://www.vaughan.ca/services/residential/by-law enforcement/Fences/Pages/default.aspx, to:

The property owner may apply for a Fence By-law Exemption as follows:

- 1. Mail to the By-law and Compliance, Licensing and Permit Services Department address, listed above.
- 2. Drop off to **drop-boxes** located at the entrances of Vaughan City Hall, with the enveloped marked, "Attn: By-law and Compliance, Licensing and Permit Services Fence By-law Exemption Application".
- 3. By e-mail to bylaw.licensing@vaughan.ca, indicating a phone number for staff to collect payment.
