## ONE WATER, ONE INTEGRATED PLAN

The Integrated Urban Water Plan is flowing. The City of Vaughan is initiating a comprehensive study of its urban water infrastructure, including water, wastewater and stormwater systems, with the purpose of supporting growth while emphasizing environmental sustainability and resiliency. The theme of this study is *integration* and it will follow a holistic approach to water infrastructure planning to ensure the City's communities and natural environment continue to thrive.

The **Integrated Urban Water Plan** will support the City's Growth Management Strategy expressed in the Official Plan and other City Master Plans.



## JOIN THE CONVERSATION

The City of Vaughan has retained Civica Infrastructure Inc. to undertake the Integrated Urban Water Plan. The goal of the study is to establish a long-term strategy to provide water, wastewater and stormwater services that are safe, reliable, resilient, environmentally sustainable and financially responsible. The study will also consider enhanced methods for managing stormwater through measures such as Low Impact

Development and will consider climate change adaptation and resiliency.

The City of Vaughan values the voice of the public and is dedicated to having constructive dialogue with the community that is open, transparent, accessible and inclusive. Vaughan is committed to involving citizens, businesses and stakeholders in conversations about municipal decisions that interest and/or impact them and collecting public input is vital to the success of the study.
