Barrhill Road and Basaltic Road

What improvements are being made

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements in your community, including new cycling facilities.

These improvements are part of the City's 2022 Pedestrian and Cycling Infrastructure Implementation Program. The construction of an in-boulevard multi-use path will connect the existing cycling trails and improve the cycling network.

Pre-construction field work | 2023

City-retained engineering consultants will be conducting field investigation activities. The various underground utilities (i.e. gas, telephone and hydro) will be identified by coloured paint markings. All roads will remain open to traffic while the field investigation work is being carried out, under the direction of the City's Infrastructure Delivery department.

Project locations

- Barrhill Road at Barrhill Pond (multi-use path, approximately 100 metres)
- Basaltic Road north of Jacob Keffer Parkway (multi-use path, approximately 220 metres)
